This is with reference to school application on the subject cited above. I am directed to convey the approval of the Board for Affiliation i.e Upgradation to Senior Secondary Level as per details given below :

Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of sections of the school shall be restricted to 30, out of which 1/3 sections should be used for Senior Secondary classes. Any further increase shall require prior approval of the Board, subject to compliance with affiliation bye laws and availability of rooms of 500 sq. ft. dimension.
2	The Land area mentioned in the land certificate is 19627 sq. mtrs. which does not match with the land area in application and OASIS i. e 16996 sq. mtrs. The school should get the land area corrected by applying in SARAS portal and submit compliance.
3	The original(vernacular) and translated copy of Building safety certificate is submitted on the Mandatory Public Disclosure. The school should submit the same on the SARAS portal and submit compliance.
4	The designation of the issuing authority of Water & Health Sanitation Certificate is not clear as it is in vernacular language. The school has submitted revised water & Health Sanitation Certificate no. PHC/KG/231/2023-24 dated 18.07.2023 on the Mandatory Public Disclosure. The school is required to submit the same on the SARAS portal and submit compliance.
5	Some part of Boundary wall is below 6 ft height with grills which is not acceptable. The school should construct concrete boundary wall of 6 feet height and submit the compliance through videography on SARAS portal within 3 months.
6	The school has submitted an undertaking to install lift to access upper floors in the Mandatory Public Disclosure in the school's website. The school should install the lift for CwSN students to access upper floors as per RPwD Act 2016 and submit the compliance through videography on SARAS portal within 3 months.
7	The CWSN toilets separately for boys and girls have been shown in the video uploaded on Mandatory Public Disclosure in the school's website. The school should submit the videography with the signages indicating the floor in which it is located within 3 months on SARAS portal.
8	The school shall ensure the training of its teachers with CoE Bengaluru within 3 months and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school

from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted with in the stipulated 3 months , the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
